



Invitation to Bid

The National Environmental Authority (NMA) in collaboration with the Ministry of Natural Resources and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) are engaged in the multi-year project **Improving Environmental Management in the Mining Sector of Suriname, with Emphasis on Artisanal and Small Scale Gold Mining (EMSAGS)**.

The EMSAGS project aims to improve environmental management in the mining sector of Suriname, with the emphasis on artisanal and small-scale gold mining as the biggest cause of deforestation in Suriname. The project is funded by, among others, the GEF through the UNDP and implementation is jointly in the hands of the Ministry of Natural Resources and NMA.

One of the objectives of the project is to establish a Mining Training and Extension Center (MTEC) at Snesi Kondre.

The EMSAGS project invites interested firms to submit a bid for the renovation and improvement of the building at Snesi Kondre, which will serve as MTEC.
