The Ministry of Finance and Planning has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Fiscal Support Program to Regain Growth (FISREG), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") includes the following deliverables:

- A work plan for to designing revenue testing and validation of collection of DoTC, within 15 working days.
- A report of testing and validation of collection from DoTC. This includes suggestions for improvement of reporting on fiscal auditing risk.
- Creating a design for revenue testing and validation of collection resources from DoTC.
- A validated coaching schedule indicating hours of coaching in revenue testing and validation of collection.
- A report on human resource advice for selection of key personnel for testing and validation of collection.
- An implementation report of Key Auditing Performance Indicators (KPI) measurements at DoTC.
- A final report detailing an overview of the work of the consultant.

The Program Implementation Unit (PIU) FISREG of the Ministry of Finance and Planning now invites eligible "Consultants" to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- At least a Master's degree in taxation, accountancy or similar degree.
- 3 to 5 years of relevant work experience.
- Affinity with the tax system from Suriname or a similar tax system.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.

- Work ethic: tenacity and following up on agreed deliverables.
- Ability to work in challenging bureaucratic environments.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team with professionals at all levels.
- Familiarity with tax software.
