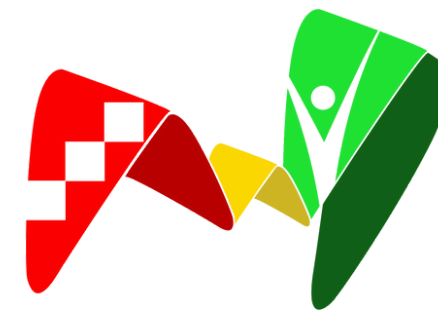

This international bidding notice was announced under the General Procurement notice advertised for this project published in Development Business Online, edition No. IDB SU-L1061 of 07-04-2025.

The Government of Suriname has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project Labor market Alignment to New Industries, for promoting the employability for jobseekers in Suriname.

The Ministry of Labor Employment Opportunity and Youth Affairs now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders to offer training for employment opportunities. These bidders will be contracted to train the program's participants in prioritized job profiles. These training opportunities should be available for participants in all districts of Suriname, ensuring that access to skills development opportunities are not limited to Paramaribo. The following 12 occupations have been carefully selected in collaboration with the private sector:

4. The type of software development the course targets (Frontend, Backend, or Full stack) and the programming language taught (Java, JavaScript, or Python) will be determined through a dialogue between the training provider and the Suriname ICT Association.



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This procurement process requires bidders to have the following specific experience and/or capabilities: Bidders must be members of eligibility countries of the IDB and prior experience in Suriname is required. Training must be conducted in physical facilities, not online. Bidders must have at least 2 years of experience delivering training programs and must demonstrate prior experience in the specific sector(s) of the course they wish to offer. Experience with social inclusion, prior work with women, ethnic minorities, rural communities, people with a disability and economically disadvantaged groups will be considered an asset

The delivery period is Six (6) months.

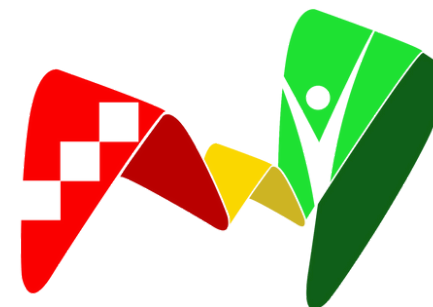
