The National Environmental Authority (NMA) in collaboration with the Ministry of Natural Resources and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) are engaged in the multi-year project Improving Environmental Management in the Mining Sector of Suriname, with Emphasis on Artisanal and Small-Scale Gold Mining (EMSAGS).

The EMSAGS Project has contracted the international firm Jacetec Solutions to design, construct and commission a mercury-free demonstration site in the district of Brokopondo.
