Vacancy Notice

The Ministry of Public Works and Spatial Planning (OWRO) in collaboration with World Wildlife Fund Guianas are engaged in the multi-year project “**Preserving Suriname’s Immense Marine and Coastal Biodiversity through Greening Infrastructure Development (Suriname GRID Project)**”.

The Suriname GRID project aims to mainstream environmental sustainability into upstream planning and development approaches for transportation infrastructure so that upcoming projects – including ports and roads – maintain or enhance the natural environment as much as feasible. It will be executed in the Suriname River where there is an unprecedented movement to invest in new ports and expand existing ports because of looming offshore and mining exploitation. The project area runs from the mouth of the Suriname River – where the Suriname River meets the Atlantic Ocean and the site of an important neotropical migratory birds and sea turtle nesting area (Braamspunt) – alongside the nation’s low-lying capital Paramaribo, and up to Paranam – an area of approximately 62,500 hectares. The project is funded by the GEF through the WWF GEF Agency and executed by the Ministry of OWRO.
