**Call for application for the Project Execution Unit
Project: Improving Transport Logistics and Competitiveness in Suriname**

The Government of the Republic of Suriname (GoS) is aiming to increase Suriname's competitiveness and productivity by improving its logistics performance. For this reason, improvements to the adjacent networks to the Port of Paramaribo are to be reconstructed. The project is intended to increase the quality of road and port infrastructure to enhance exports of agricultural goods. It is expected that the project will result in lower logistic costs and trace times, thus improving the ease of trade and competitiveness and improving resilience standards of road and port infrastructure.

This will be done through an investment project executed by the Ministry of Public Works and Spatial Planning (MPWSP). For this project, the Government of Suriname requested financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB).

MPWSP is soliciting expressions of interest from potential individual consultants interested in joining the Project Execution Unit.

To implement this Project, the minimum expertise of individual consultants is needed for the following position:

1. Construction Engineer (Full-time assignment. Tentative starting in October 2026)
 - Bachelor's degree or superior in Civil Engineering or Construction.
 - Master's degree or specialization studies in heavy construction is considered a plus.
 - Master's degree in project management and PMP or similar certification are considered a plus.
 - At least 7 years of practical experience managing large and complex infrastructure projects.
 - Knowledge of Suriname public institutions and administration procedures is a plus.
 - Experience in IDB or other multilateral/international institutions projects is considered a plus.
 - Good organizational, analytical, teambuilding, problem solving, communication and negotiating (including conflict resolution) skills;
 - Ability to quickly build and maintain productive relationships with high level Government officials and other key stakeholders;
 - Public speaking/oral presentation skills;
 - Demonstratable Knowledge in Secretarial and Office Administration and skilled in the use of MS Office.
 - Familiarity with IDB or other international organization's procurement procedures and guidelines is considered an asset
 - Strong written and verbal communication skills, both in Dutch and English.

The Ministry of Public Works and Spatial Planning invites eligible individuals to submit their Curriculum Vitae showing their qualification to perform their services to the email below. Interested consultants must provide information establishing that they are qualified to perform the services (description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills, etc. and should be available on a full-time basis (40 hours per week).
